The assistants will handle all aspects of museum work: cleaning and maintaining the museum facility and its exhibits, welcoming guests, answering phones, and attending to birthday parties. The assistant's job is to support the ECM's mission by enriching the lives of children through a positive experience when visiting the museum.

- Provide exemplary customer service in welcoming, cashing in and out, and interacting with the guests at the museum.
- Provide guests with overviews of the museum exhibits and activities.
- Interact with museum guests in a friendly and positive manner throughout the museum experience.
- Accurately handle all transactions through the POS system.
- Answer the phone and direct calls in a professional manner.
- Assist in maintaining the museum exhibits, including but not limited to cleaning and disinfecting exhibit components.
- Assist in the general janitorial duties throughout the museum as directed.
